**OBJECTIVE**

The high-level event will welcome approximately eighty participants, whereas the workshop part of this seminar will host around fifty participants from various countries, outside the European Union at different stages of CCE implementation. Participants will be educational system officers, academics in charge of teacher’s professional development, international cooperation education officers, funders and other stakeholders in CCE. Please note, all participants to the 3 days workshop are expected to attend the high level event.

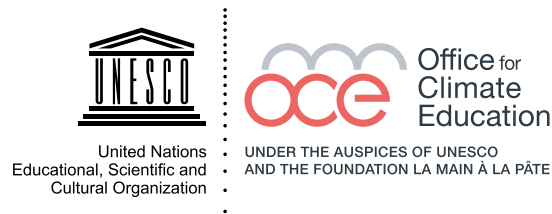
